Boil Water Notice Issued for St. Lucie Utilities Customers in a Small Section of the LWP Sampson Subdivision

FORT PIERCE – Due to a loss of power at the Lakewood Park Plant, roughly 70 St. Lucie County Utilities’ customers in the Sampson Subdivision are under a precautionary boil water notice.

Residents inside Deland Avenue to Donion Road from Fort Pierce Boulevard to Roland Court are under a precautionary boil water notice.

The St. Lucie County Utilities Department advises that any water used for drinking or cooking be boiled. A rolling boil of one minute is sufficient. Bottled water may be used as an alternative.
