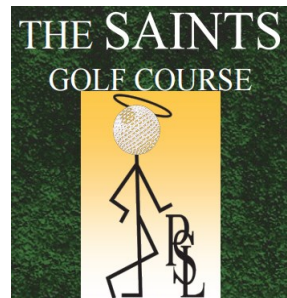


Thank You!!

All participants are required to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to their tee time. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to advance a tee time up 15 minutes earlier if necessary.

Players that fail to show without due notice will not be permitted to play in their next scheduled event.

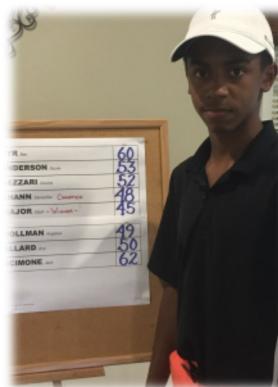

low stress environment ensuring all juniors enjoy the experience. The number of holes and tee locations will be determined by both the age and skill level of the participants. If a junior does not have a partner to play with the tour directors will pair the players. Each week prizes will be given for the low teams/players within the various divisions.

Sample Formats

The SLCJGT's mission is to provide a FUN experience for young people to enjoy the game. In order to accomplish this goal alternative formats that are low stress and less intimidating than stroke play are utilized. For new players a scramble format is used. Team games are featured to encourage working together and supporting fellow players.

The final event of the summer, the St. Lucie County Junior Championship hosted by Fairwinds is individual stroke play. However, various divisions are featured to create a fair and balanced event.

Player Rules and Regulations

Dress Code: All participants are required to wear a shirt with a collar during all tournaments. Shirts must be tucked in. Appropriate golf shorts or skirts are permitted. No jeans, denim, short shorts or athletic shorts will be permitted.

Shoes: Golf shoes with soft spikes only allowed, no metal spikes. Sneakers or shoes with soft rubber soles are permitted.

Golf Cars: Players are prohibited from driving or riding in golf cars unless authorized by an official in an emergency situation.

Pull Carts: Players are allowed to use a pull cart if they are permitted by the host facility.

Behavior: Profane language, club throwing, damaging the course, unsportsmanlike conduct, cheating, or violating course rules will result in disqualification from the event and possible dismissal from the SLCJGT.

Pace of Play: Slow play is not fun for anyone. The SLCJGT will play ready golf. All groups will be expected to keep up with the group ahead of them.

Rain Policy: In the event of thunderstorms, participants will be required to immediately discontinue play when notified by a long blast of the siren. Players should mark the location of their ball and seek shelter. If possible, the players should return to the clubhouse. Every effort will be made to complete the round. If this is not possible events will not be rescheduled

Parent/Guardian

Rules & Responsibilities

Player Arrival: Players should arrive one half hour prior to their scheduled tee time. The committee reserves the right to advance a tee time up to 15 minutes earlier if necessary.

Player Departure: For Safety reasons, prompt pick-up of your child is appreciated.

Adult Golf Car Usage: Parents must get permission for golf car usage from the golf course hosting a particular tournament. **Fees for use of golf cars are determined by the hosting golf course.**

Player Supervision: Parents/guardians/friends are encouraged to assist their junior with scoring, rules and pace of play. Parents should not give swing advice to any player. Parents remember the goal of the SLCJGT is FUN! It's not about the competition so please help out and make all the players feel good about playing the game.
