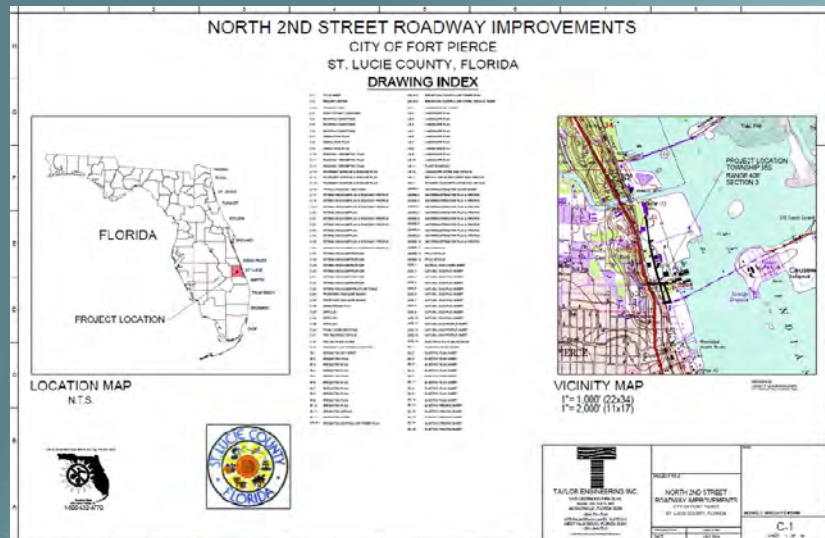




# Port of Fort Pierce North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Roadway Improvements



- Project Location: North of Seaway Drive just East of US Hwy 1
- This project is a partnership project with the City of Fort Pierce, (FP) Fort Pierce Utility Authority (FPUA) the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and St. Lucie County (SLC)



Work is currently being performed at N 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, north of Seaway Drive and just east of US Hwy 1. No significant traffic delays are expected.

## North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Roadway Improvements



- Project Budget: \$ 6.3 M (FDOT/SLC - Design & Construct) (50/50 Match Grant Funds)
  - \$ 465 K (FP - CEI)
  - \$ 530 K (FPUA - Install)
  - Total \$ 7.295 M
- Construction Start Date: March 2015
- Estimated Construction Completion Date: February 2017
- Description: Widening and resurfacing North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Indian River Drive, Fisherman's Warf, and Avenue H, in the City of Fort Pierce. The project will improve the stormwater drainage to the Indian River Lagoon and Taylor Creek areas, and will upgrade utilities to the area.
