#### **CONSTRUCTION SITE COORDINATORS NEEDED FOR LONG TERM RECOVERY**

Fort Pierce – December 27, 2006 – St. Lucie Inspired Network to Achieve Community Together (INTACT), the county's long term recovery organization, and Habitat for Humanity are in need of 2-3 AmeriCorps Volunteers to serve as Construction Site Coordinators. AmeriCorps applicants need to have some construction knowledge and be comfortable teaching and supervising groups of volunteers. Those selected for these positions would be participating in the Hurricane Mitigation Program sponsored by INTACT, the Florida Hurricane Relief Fund, and the State of Florida and with other construction projects through St. Lucie Habitat for Humanity.

INTACT was awarded funds to assist lower income homeowners, including the elderly and persons with disabilities, to better prepare their homes to withstand hurricanes. Mitigation is defined as home modifications that make a home more resistant to wind damage. This may include installation of hurricane shutters, repair/replacement of doors/windows, and upgrades to roofing to minimize damage from wind and rain.

AmeriCorps Volunteers receive a living allowance, health coverage, and an education stipend.
