RULES AND REGULATIONS

OPEN 8:00 a.m. TO DUSK

St. Lucie County reserves the right to close the facility as needed

THIS IS AN UNSUPERVISED SKATE PARK.

All skaters must know their own abilities and skate at their own risk.

THE PARK IS A DRUG FREE, ALCOHOL FREE AND TOBACCO FREE ZONE.

Skaters under the age of 18 are required to have a skate card to enter the facility. To obtain a skate card, a notarized waiver signed by skater's parent or guardian must be on record with St. Lucie County Parks & Recreation. Waivers and skate cards are available Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. at 1302 Virginia Avenue, Fort Pierce, FL in the SLC Sports & Athletics office.

Skaters 18 + must have valid photo ID on them at all times.

Card holders must have their skate card on them at all times.

NO BICYCLES, SCOOTERS, OR MOTORIZED VEHICLES ALLOWED.

All skaters are required to wear a helmet and shirt at all times. Skaters are encouraged to wear elbow and knee pads.

Skate Park is open during posted hours. It is illegal for any person to enter the skate park when it is closed.

- ❑ **Anyone in the Skate Park when it is closed will be subject to arrest for TRESSPASSING.**

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

No additional obstacles, such as benches, ramps, etc. are allowed inside the skate area or along any of the skating surface.

No food, beverages or chewing gum is allowed outside of the picnic tables/pavilion areas. No glass containers of any kind are allowed in the park. PLEASE PLACE ALL LITTER IN TRASH CANS.

ANY VIOLATION OF THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN THE PARTICIPANT'S IMMEDIATE EJECTION FROM THE PARK AND MAY RESULT IN LONG-TERM LOSS OF PARK PRIVILEGES.
