About Us:

The St Lucie County Drug Lab is located at 218 South 2nd St., Fort Pierce, and is open from 8:00am-4:30pm Mon-Fri, and 406 NW 3rd Ave., in Okeechobee. Call 863-824-6060 for hours of operation.

All specimens are processed on an Olympus AU400 Analyzer in Fort Pierce and a Siemens V-Twin Analyzer in Okeechobee, using Siemens and Immulysis reagents and chemicals. Results are usually available on the same day. Results may be viewed on our password protected web based portal, which is HIPAA compliant.

County and Circuit Hotline:

The St Lucie County Drug Lab operates the County Drug Screening Hotline for Pretrial, Mental Health Court, Dependency Court and CORE Probation. The St Lucie County Drug Lab also operates the 19th Circuit Drug Screening Hotline for Drug Court participants. Defendants or litigants who have been ordered to take random drug screens must call the Hotline every day including weekends. The numbers are based on birth month.

The frequency of each birth month called on each hotline varies. You can place a person who is not participating in any court program mentioned above, on one of the hotlines. This places the responsibility on the person testing and no one has to call the person to take a test (no dodging phone calls or ignoring texts)

Family Court Parents:

Parenting children from separate households is never easy but when one parent is suspected of abusing drugs or alcohol, visitation becomes problematic and even dangerous. Parents can use the St Lucie County Drug Lab to test before and after visitation, to ensure drug use is not an issue during visitation.

The testing parent should arrive at the lab as early in the day as possible so the results can be ready the same day. Results can be emailed directly to the other parent and the attorneys if applicable.

If the suspected parent has frequent visitation, using the hotline might be a better option. The frequency of testing varies from once per month, twice per month, once per week to multiple times per week. Deadlines to arrive at the lab can be included in the court's order.

All test results are confidential and will only be released to the parent and attorneys agreed upon.
