

ALARM SYSTEMS CONTRACTOR - CLASS II (NO FIRE ALARM)

DESCRIPTION:

An alarm system contractor - Class II scope of services is limited to the execution of contracts requiring the ability, experience, science, knowledge and skill to lay out, fabricate, install, maintain, alter, repair, monitor, inspect, replace or service all types of alarm systems, ***other than fire***, for all purposes as regulated by Part II, Chapter 489, Florida Statutes.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

All applicants for a St. Lucie County Alarm System Contractor - Class II license shall provide written proof of having three **(3) years** field experience in the alarm system trade.

All applicants for a St. Lucie Alarm Systems Contractor Class II must pass with a **70%**.

All applicants for a St Lucie Alarm Systems Contractor Class II must provide proof of insurance of having a minimum of \$100,000 General Liability & \$25,000 Property Damage.

The minimum Net Worth is **\$2,500**.

APPLICATION AND REQUIRED FEES:

Applications for St. Lucie County Alarm System Contractor - Class II license must be filed with the required, non-refundable fee of **\$150**.

STATE REGISTRATION:

State Registration is required.

STATE CERTIFICATION:

State Certification is available
