


PUBLIC NOTICE

NOW IN EFFECT

Ordinance N. 2020-021 calls for the mandatory wearing of face coverings for anyone in public in places, where social distancing isn't possible.



To help slow the spread of COVID-19, St. Lucie County Board of County Commissioners passed Ordinance N. 2020-021 requiring everyone to wear a facial covering when social distancing isn't possible both for indoor and outdoor settings. Face coverings, which cover both the nose and mouth, must be worn by all individuals at indoor or outdoor public places and businesses including retail stores, offices and restaurants. Those dining, both indoor or outdoor, do not have to wear facial coverings while consuming food or beverages. Subject to certain exemptions.
