



## Yarn Art – Spider’s Web

Did you know?

It is estimated that one spider can eat as many as 2,000 insects in a year. Because of their broad appetite, many spiders play an important role in their communities by regulating the density of other invertebrate herbivores and predators. When you account for the variety of food types they consume and their sheer abundance, spiders are some of the most important invertebrate predators in terrestrial ecosystems. Try this!

You’ll need any color yarn, wax paper, a bottle of glue and a printout of the spider web on the next page.



1. Place a layer of wax paper over the entire spider web printout.
2. Trace the whole web with lines of glue.
3. Place the yarn over the lines of glue.
4. Squeeze lines of glue over the lines of yarn.
5. Let the glue and yarn dry for 24 hours, then peel your web off the wax paper and hang your spider web somewhere fun!
